William Caslon founded the Caslon Foundryell's Foundry inpreviously Godfrey Head's. The other half was purchased by John James, son of Thomas James. John James also purchased at around, which became the leading English typefoundry of theth and earlyth centuries. He acquired moiety of half of Robert Mitch Jacob llive in and later an important purchase was the foundry of Thomas Grover in - ultimately combining under his direction nine old English Foundries according to Talbot Reed's The Old English letter Foundries. John James, William Caslon I and Baskerville as the only three representatives of the trade in the country. William Caslon I had two apprentices in his Sheffield Foundry, Thomas Cottrell and Joseph Jackson. They started a foundry of their own in direct competition to their employer in. In Jackson entered the Navy leaving Cottrell to carry on alone. Jackson left the navy in and continued to be employed in Thomas Cottrell, Neveil's court Foundry for a short time. He commenced business in a separate Foundry
